1. Complete acquirer details on the left of this form.
2. Attend an Access Canberra Service Centre to complete the transfer of registration within 14 calendar days of purchase or a penalty for late transfer will be charged.
3. If you send someone else to register the vehicle in your name, you must complete an 'Authority to act as Agent' form.
4. Stamp Duty may be collectable on applicable vehicle transfers. Visit www.act.gov.au/duty for further information about how duty is calculated and which fee will apply.
5. You must provide proof of identity and notification of the vehicle's ACT garaging address.
6. If the vehicle is more than 6 years old with a GVM of 4.5 tonnes or less, a valid passed Certificate of Inspection must be presented at time of transfer.
